The word we received is the **best possible word** that we could have received. Maureen's Doctor was able to do her surgery laposcopically with robotics. He removed the tumor and very little else. This tumor was blocking the exit from the stomach to the intestines. The duodenal had to be moved which means that food may remain in the stomach longer than normal. She will be in the hospital up to five days and then return home for further recovery. On behalf of Maureen I thank you for your prayers!
