Give Through an ELCA Life Income Agreement

You can make a gift for the ministry of the church, and continue to receive income!

There are a number of ways in which you can make a gift now for the ultimate benefit of ELCA ministries, and continue to receive income. These life income agreements include charitable gift annuities, deferred payment charitable gift annuities, and charitable remainder trusts.

You may choose any ELCA ministry to receive the charitable remainder of your gift. You may name your congregation, churchwide ministry, synod, social ministry organization, college, seminary, disaster relief, ELCA World Hunger Appeal, Fund for Leaders in Mission, etc. You can provide for more than one charitable beneficiary with a life income agreement, up to a maximum of ten charitable beneficiaries.
